

Planning Port's future waterfront



Port Douglas has long been one of the nation's premier tourist destinations, and Council is now taking stock and planning strategically for the future of the town's waterfront.

The Port Douglas Waterfront Master Plan project aims to develop a practical plan for the area bounded by Port Street and the coastline around to Four Mile Beach.

It will address the numerous tenures and uses of the waterfront, and ensure guidance for future development to meet the needs of the community, our visitors, businesses and the environment.

Over the next six months, the content of the Master Plan will be determined. The master planning process will affect many interested parties and Council is committed to a collaborative approach to planning.

Members of the community will have an opportunity to get involved in this exciting project through an Enquiry by Design process, which will be advertised later this year.
